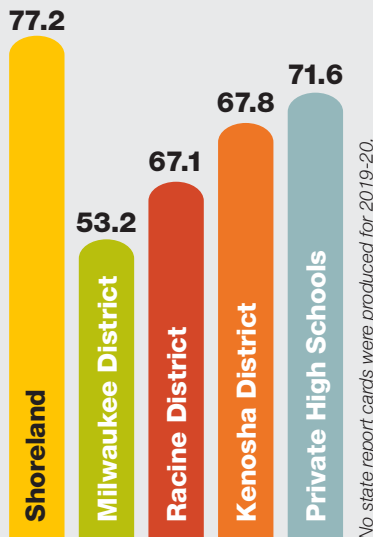

Wisconsin State Report Card

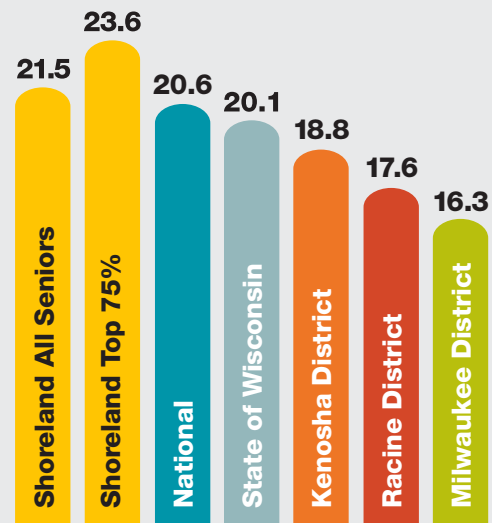

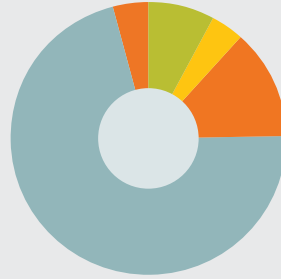
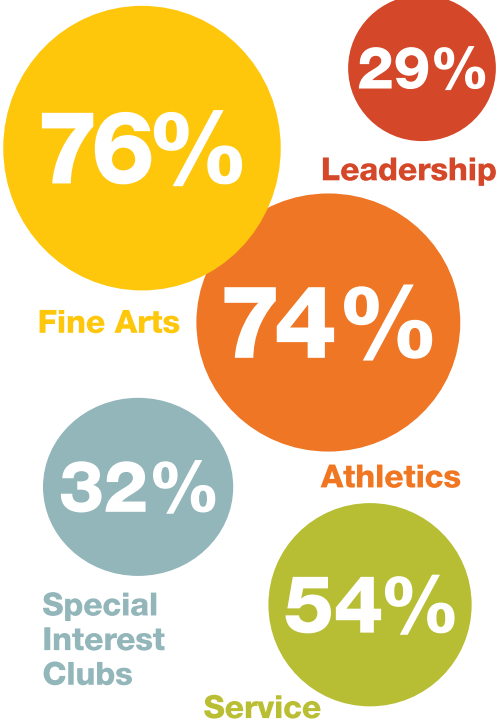
